is a family of diverse families.

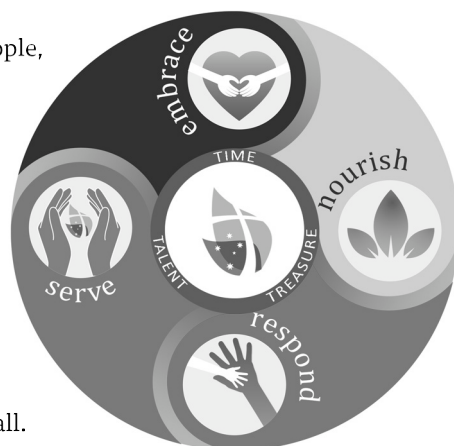

To join this Ministry, you must be at least 16 years of age.

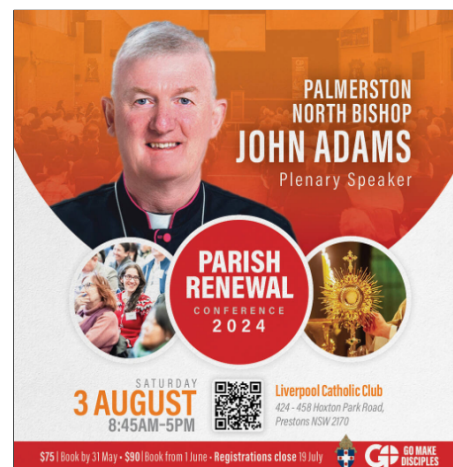
COMMUNITY MEETING AT ST MARY MOTHER OF GOD

FOSTER CARE CRISIS

At the most recent Council of Priests meeting, CatholicCare's CEO, Michael Austin, presented on a current crisis engulfing NSW (and especially in our Diocese) in relation to foster care.

Over 350 children and young people in NSW are seeking foster care. Close to 100 of the 350 are living in our Diocese alone.

These children and young people are living in high cost, emergency placements while waiting for permanent foster care homes, being placed in hotels, serviced apartments, or even caravan parks, all while being cared for by rotating staff.

Please collect a CatholicCare prayer card from the Welcome Table which contains details of how parishioners can contact CatholicCare to discuss foster caring.

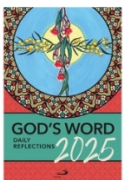
