2023 STATIONS OF LIGHT DURING EASTER

Thank you to all those who gathered to pray the Via Crucis during Lent.

Following the model of the Via Crucis (Stations of the Cross) through the praying of the Stations of Light we have the opportunity to meditate on the various appearances of the Risen Lord - from his Resurrection to his Ascension.



So this year, on some of the Fridays of the Easter Season (namely Friday 21 April, 28 April, 5 May, 12 May and 19 May) you are invited to gather at 7pm in our Oran Park Mass Centre to pray the Stations of Light (during a time of Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament) and in the presence of the Easter Candle.

These Stations will be led by different members of our parish community.

Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.



ADULT FAITH FORMATION "FAITH NIGHT"


