Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.

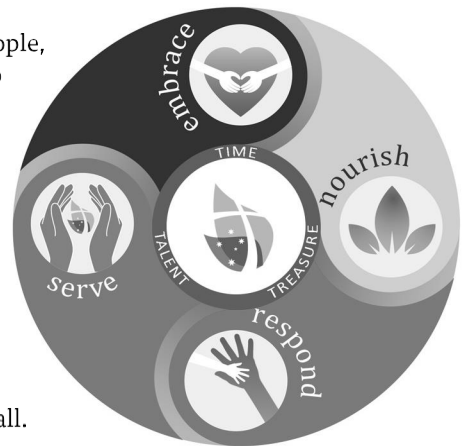
We are sustained by the **Sacraments** and nurtured in our faith in **Jesus Christ**.

WALK FOR HIM

As some have already heard, Fr David had a fall while packing up after our Parish's 1st Holy Communion Masses that were held last Saturday. Fr David was sent to hospital by ambulance and following CT scan and other tests, the medical team identified he has non-displayed fractures of both nasal bones, as well as other facial injuries. Fr David was discharged from hospital in the early hours of last Sunday morning. Due to his fall and injuries, last Sunday's WALK FOR HIM had to be postponed.

Fr David – with the support of Bishop Brian - will now be taking a period of recuperation leave (until the end of July)

Mindful that so many have already said they want to join with Fr David to complete this special walk, we are pleased to announce that **'WALK FOR HIM 2.0'** will be held on Sunday 4th August following our 10am Sunday Mass. This date has been chosen to coincide with the weekend we will celebrate, at our parish Masses, the feastday of our patron St Mary MacKillop. Fr David would like to thank all those who have supported him as part of the Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia WALK FOR HIM initiative. Over \$19,000 has been raised and the tally is still climbing: www.walkforhim.org.au/fundraisers/frdavidcatterall - this is truly a remarkable response, that currently sees Fr David be 'on top of the national tally board'. Fr David is so happy that the funds raised will be able to support life-saving research and support services for those, like him, diagnosed with prostate cancer. 🙏
